<p>Note: You have but one person to blame or thank for the star (*) rating system ...Richard. Since I've heard almost all the presentations, at least my opinion is based on the most <i>complete</i> data available. About two years ago, one presenter complained that he was rated 2 stars. Actually, he spent the better part of an hour wasting our time telling us about his personal life... His complaint prompted me to remove the stars... but members kept asking me which presentation would be best place to start. All presentations contain value; however, some are better. After much thought, I sat back down and rated the presentations... again... thinking through all aspects: applicability, content, pace, value, etc. This is the only way I know to answer comprehensively. Based on the bell curve, one will probably note that the majority are rated 3 stars while some are rated a 2 and a few are rated 4 (best). Rough count = 20 four stars; 50 three stars; and 15 two stars. Most of the new presentations include visuals; however, the early ones don't. We just didn't think about requesting visuals until members listening in from afar requested them.</p>					
<p>To get the most from the recorded presentations I suggest you listen to one you 'think' you will like which includes visuals. If you like it, keep on listening to others on a periodic basic. Don't try too many at once... just one or two a day would probably be best. I would analyze all available presentations using the six different sorts and from your analysis, select the first 10 you believe will do you the most good... based on what you think you want to learn about trading. I'm convinced that if you are a good observer and a studious individual, that you could POSSIBLY learn to trade BY just listening to about 50 of the hundred presentations ALREADY available or available very soon.</p>
